Replacement Battery

Important:

It is illegal for anyone, except for a licensed electrician to install or maintain this product. Before installation, ensure that the electricity supply has been switched off and isolated. Installation must be carried out in accordance with the relevant Australian and International Standards.


Installation:

This NIFTY Recessed Non-maintained Emergency can be installed on PLASTER or T-BAR ceilings or used to replace an existing unit.

- Refer Images and Dimensions below for the Cut-out Hole and other dimensions.
- Pull and Connect the power cord to the power supply socket.
- Fold back the spring clips and insert product into cut out.
- Please ensure the ceiling is capable of supporting the product weight in compliance with the relevant regulations with respect to mounting above/on the ceiling.

Dimensions:

In ceiling depth: 45mm Head: 110mm diameter (with adaptor ring 140mm) Cut-out Hole: Recommended 90mm diameter (up to 130mm with adaptor ring)



Battery Replacement:

- 1. Prior to any work, isolate the power to the luminaire that requires battery replacement
- 2. Open the battery cover found on the top side of the product.
- 3. Remove the Battery Connector from the Emergency PCA.
- 4. Remove the battery from the battery compartment
- 5. Replace battery with the same type and part number and connect the battery connector to the Emergency Driver.
- 6. Secure the battery cover

Testing:

When the NIFTY is connected to the un-switched active, it must be allowed to charge the battery for at least 24 hours. The emergency lamp only illuminates during a power fail. Conduct the following tests:

- The emergency lamp must illuminate for at least 2 hours after disconnection from the mains. The results of all tests are required to be recorded in a service logbook, which is to be kept on-site at all times. If the unit fails to illuminate for the requisite time, remedial action must be taken to repair the situation and once completed, the unit must pass a subsequent test.
- Press and hold Test Button or switch Off Mains Supply, check that the emergency lamp is On.
- Release the Test Button or Switch On Mains Supply, check that the emergency lamp is Off (Nonmaintained operation).

Trouble Shooting:

The Green LED indicator is not illuminated. Fault: Check: A.C. is connected and is turned on. Battery is connected. Test Switch for damage. Fault: Lamp does not illuminate in emergency mode. Check: A.C. is connected. Lamp Head is correctly connected. Battery is connected Lamp illuminates in emergency mode, but only stays on for a short period. Fault: Check: Battery has been allowed to charge for at least 24 hours. Battery for damage. Fault: Green LED flashes once every 5 seconds-Battery is disconnected Battery is connected. Check: Green LED blinks off once every 5 seconds- Charging very flat battery Fault: Allow 20min to recover battery then recheck Green LED flashes at 2Hz (Fast flash)- Faulty battery Fault: Replace battery Rated Emergency Lumen Output in accordance with AS2293.1(refer to spacing tables for installation positions): Refer to the Technical Label for classification information Caution: On many building sites, power circuits may be cut off in an uncontrolled and repetitive basis during

construction. As a result, any Exit & Emergency Units, on these circuits, will have their batteries discharged or "cycled". The battery in this fitting has been selected to give excellent long-life performance in a controlled AS2293 testing environment. Excessive battery cycling will reduce through-life performance and may lead to premature battery failure. Battery warranty claims, as a result of such abuse, are specifically EXCLUDED from Clevertronics warranty terms.
